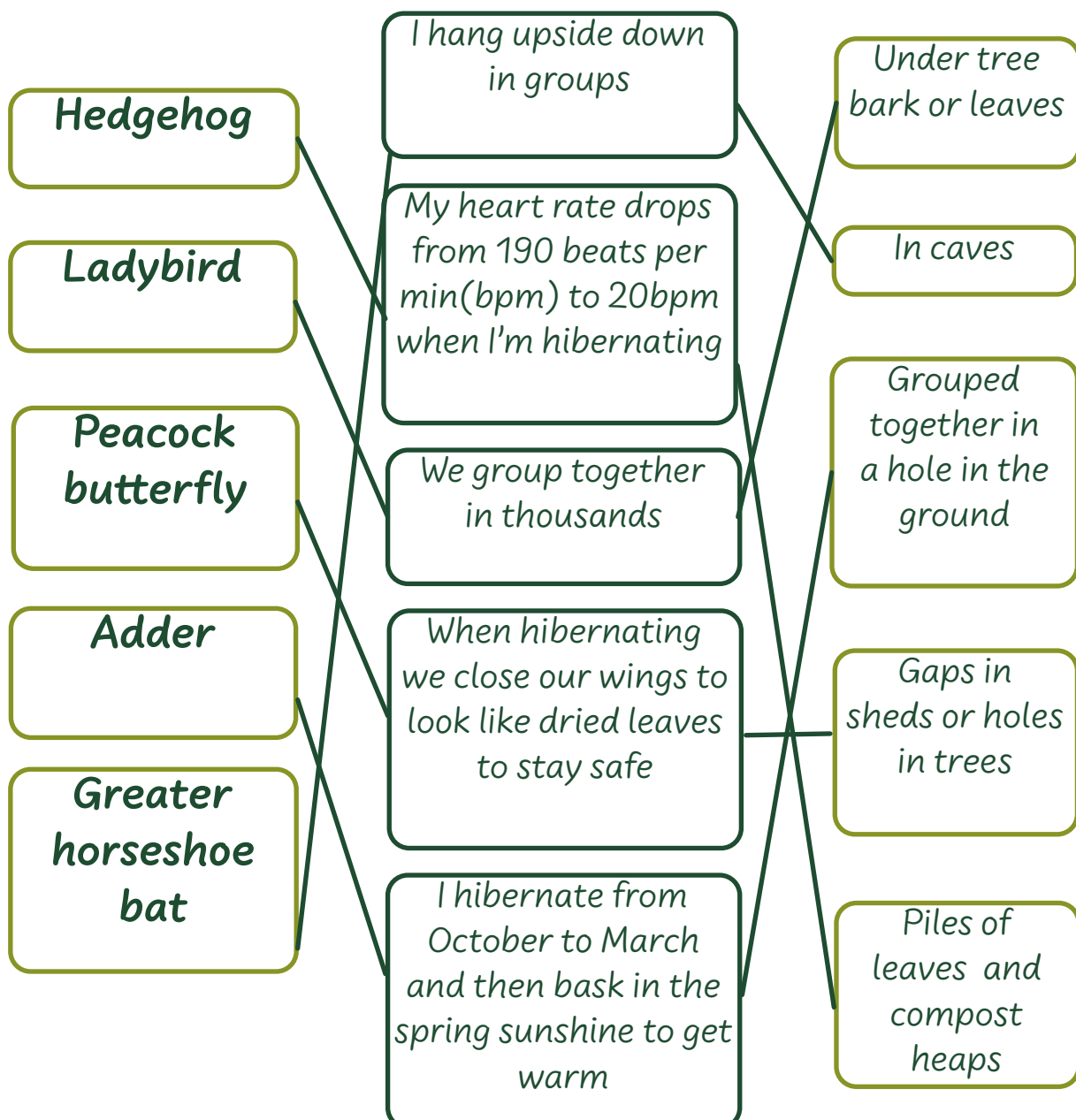

# Hibernation



## Game rules

**Hedgehog**

I hang upside down in groups

Under tree bark or leaves

**Ladybird**

My heart rate drops from 190 beats per min(bpm) to 20bpm when I'm hibernating

In caves

**Peacock butterfly**

We group together in thousands

Grouped together in a hole in the ground

**Adder**

When hibernating we close our wings to look like dried leaves to stay safe

Gaps in sheds or holes in trees

**Greater horseshoe bat**

I hibernate from October to March and then bask in the spring sunshine to get warm

Piles of leaves and compost heaps



The 17 species of British bat all hibernate during the winter.
